

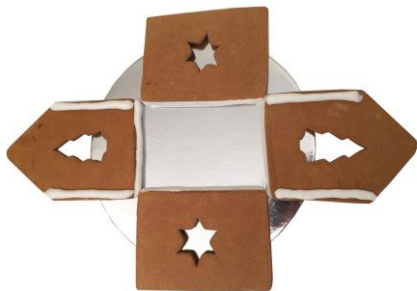
STEP-BY-STEP INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW TO BUILD A JORDAN'S GINGERBREAD HOUSE

Store Icing in fridge or cool place. When needed bring back to room temperature and gently massage before piping.

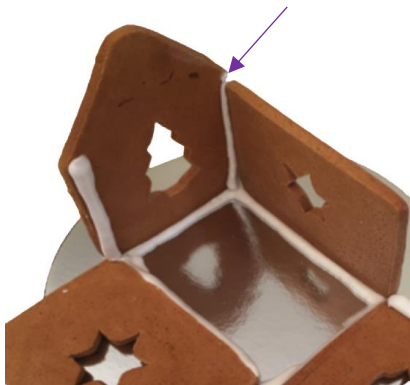
Step 1 – Set Up

- Position gingerbread flat surface up and raised surface down on silver board.
- Snip icing bag.
- Pipe icing on bottom edges of all pieces.
- Pipe two lines of icing on tree walls.



Step 2 – Build House

- Stand up star and tree wall pieces in an L shape. Star wall sits inside tree wall.
- Stick to board.
- Stand other two pieces up in same way.



Step 3 – Strengthen House

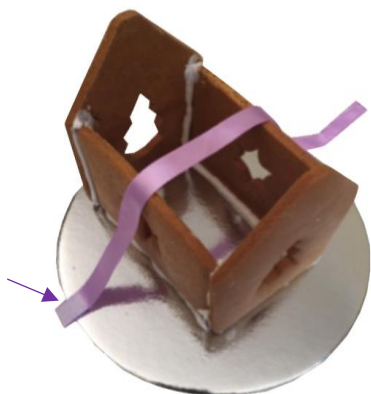
- Pipe extra icing along the inside of each join and along the inside base.

Leave 10mins to set



Step 4 – Lay Ribbon Fastener

- Lay ribbon over house, with smaller piece of Velcro facing upwards. Smaller piece of Velcro has a scratchy feel.



Step 5 – Pipe Icing For Roof

- Pipe icing on apex of house.



Step 6 – Put Roof On

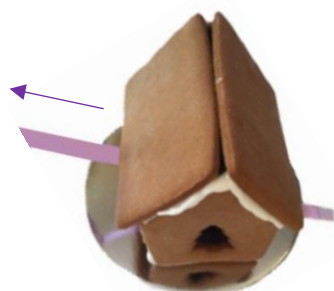
- Align roof pieces and press onto icing.
- Pieces should touch along the peak.
- Secure ribbon over roof with Velcro.

Leave 10 -20 mins to set



Step 7 – Remove Ribbon

- Undo ribbon.
- Cut Velcro off, close to the edge.
- Pull out gently. Ribbon may be reused to fasten cello.



Step 8 – Strengthen Roof

- Pipe a line of icing along peak of roof and fill with lollies.



Step 9 -Decorate house

- Decorate house with lollies.
- Wrap completed house in cello to keep fresh and secure with ribbon.
